

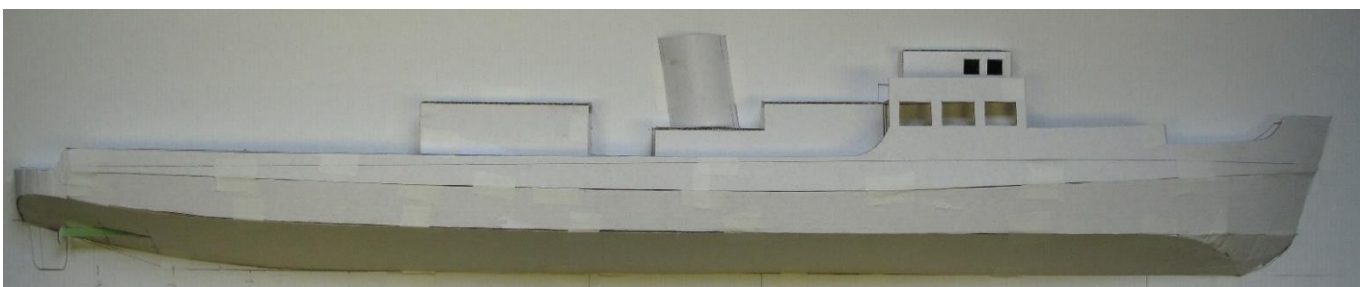
An exciting venue for practical learning with engineering ambassadors



Build a Ship on Ship – An annual programme for Key Stage 4 (14 to 16 year olds)
October 10th 11th 12th 13th 2017 – Wapping Wharf / Prince Street Bridge Bristol BS1 4RH

Led by a shipwright and specialist facilitators working with a team of STEM ambassadors from local maritime engineering industries such as Rolls-Royce, Babcock and BMT.

Students will explore the ship moored in Bristol's Historic Floating Harbour. Working as a team to gather the parts and information needed to build a metre long model boat. The emphasis is on teamwork and construction skills that result in each team presenting an annotated model that shows learning about maritime engineering; history; economy, the future of shipping and jobs in this sector. This model is non sailing, it reveals the interior structure as well as the exterior lines. Models are kept by the students for display in school . A class of 30 will create six boat. Boats will be displayed on our website and prizes for the best boats will be awarded in May when the Balmoral begins its summer
